SYNTAX residencies

SYNTAX is a newly developed art structure devoted to production, presentation, promotion and stimulation of international contemporary art practice in Lisbon. Our main goal is to provide a functional environment for creation and new encounters that will lead to the exchange of knowledge and ideas.

SYNTAX residencies for artists are an integral part of SYNTAX run activities. Our program is project based, with a focus on production and presentation of artistic practice. We offer a highly personalized program, based on cooperation with local artists, art professionals and organizations.

What do we offer

SYNTAX residencies offer a two-month residency stay in Lisbon, Portugal. We provide our residents with accommodation and cover their travel expenses. Selected resident will be also granted a residency/production/exhibition budget in the total amount of 1500Euros.

An essential part of each residency stay is an exhibition of the artists work, and a series of public events, nature of which will be decided up on the arrival of the artist.

Residency dates

The dates of the residency are fixed for 5.9. – 5.11.2015 and cannot be changed. We therefore ask all applicants to kindly take the residency dates into consideration when sending their applications.

Who can apply

We are looking for emerging to mid carrier Hungarian (or Hungary based) artists working in the field of visual arts, who would like to work and engage with the creative context of Portugal/and the area of Southern Europe and develop a new, or finalize an already existing project.

Selection process

The final resident will be selected by a board of SYNTAX partner representatives – professionals from the Czech Republic, Hungary, Poland, Portugal and Slovakia working in the area of visual culture. The selection will be closed by March 15th and the selected resident will be informed up on this date or earlier. The result of the open call will be also published on the website of the Centre for Contemporary Art Prague and SYNTAX.
